



485 Temporary Graduate – Document Check List

Check	Personal Documents
	Certified copies of the bio pages of the passports of all people included in the application
	A certified copy of your birth certificate showing both parents' names.
	Two recent passport-sized photographs (45 mm x 35 mm) of each person included in the application.
	Certified copy of evidence of the name change (if applicable)
	Certified copies of marriage certificates or relationship registrations for you and anyone else included in your application, even if they are not joining you in Australia
	If you are in a de facto relationship: evidence that you have been in the relationship for at least 12 months
Check	Family members English language ability
	Each of your dependent applicants who are aged 18 years or older at the time of application must provide evidence of Functional English
Check	Health and character documents
	Police checks for you and everyone included in your application, whether they are migrating or not, who is at least 16 years of age – of every country where they spent 12 months or more since turning 16 years of age
	Military service record or discharge papers (when applicable)
Check	Character documents
	The AFP National Police Check Application
	You might need to provide police certificates from each country in which anyone in your application has spent a total of 12 months or more in the past 10 years since turning 16 years of age.
Check	The Australian study requirement
	Completion letters from your education provider stating
	Certified copies of course transcripts
Check	Documents to show English Language ability
	The results of a specified English language test (IELTS, OET, Pearson Test of English Academic, or TOEFL iBT) that you took less than three years before lodging your application.



Additional documents for Graduate Work stream applicants

Graduate Work stream documents

Provide these documents with your application if you are applying in the Graduate Work stream.

Skills assessment for your nominated occupation (which is on the list of eligible skilled occupations) – either:

Evidence of your successful skills assessment in which the relevant assessing authority has assessed your skills as suitable for your nominated occupation, or

Evidence that you have applied to the relevant assessment authority for a skills assessment for your nominated occupation.
